Well, the heat has arrived. We really need it for our crops to get back on track but it is hard to work in the stifling humidity and heat. When I get done at the end of the day, I just want a dark room to take a break from the sun.

We have strawberries. If you want a flat of berries to make jam or to freeze, this is your week. We are getting our berries from Senek Farm and from our Amish neighbor. Buy through our custom order to add on to your delivery next week. Orders will need to be placed on Sunday by 5 so we can source the berries on time. Berries are \$50/flat.

After a successful launch of the weekly shares we will be doing the biweekly shares next week. We will be sending an email with your day of delivery information.

Please set out a cooler that is about 60 qt on your stoop. This allows us to pull the bag from the delivery box and put in the cooler. If you are home it is no big deal to leave the box, but please get it into refrigeration as soon as possible. We reuse the boxes so leave them for the next pickup.

Home delivery is our way of reducing fuel and time obligations for our share members. We use about 10 gallons of gas on a typical delivery run to deliver about 36 boxes and share items. With some rough math, we figure to save at least 24 gallons of fuel and 36 man hours for each delivery. We hope you put that hour to good use!

Our custom order form can be used any week of your delivery to add meats, bread, sweet treats, eggs or other things to your order. This week we have flats of strawberries. We will be offering larger quantities of produce as the season goes on. We will highlight in our newsletters what is available.

Farm stand hours: Saturdays 9-2, Thursdays 2-6. Self serve hours will start in July. Monday-Saturday 9-4.
