This is a weekly week coming up. We will have blueberries for our fruit, if everything comes together.

We have blue berry flats available. These are from Blueberry Haven in Arcade, NY. Arlene has not sprayed anything on the blueberries. This will be a short blueberry season. We will have blueberries for 2-3 weeks. We may not be able to supply all of the orders at once for flats. We will let you know when yours is being delivered.

There will be pickle cukes available for the next couple weeks. They are sold by the half bushel. Half bushels of summer squash and zucchini as well.

We will have fresh chicken available for markets this weekend. Put in your fresh chicken orders via the custom order link. This week's fresh chicken is all whole chickens. We did not get to whole chicken slaughter in time for this weeks shares.

Harvest season is here. We started pulling beets for storage. The cold start to the season has left 3 plantings of corn unusable. Our first sweetcorn will be in about 2 weeks. It is tasseled out and starting to silk.

When ordering from the custom order form for a home delivery csa, please pay by credit card or have a check ready for the payment of additional items. These additional items are not included in your share and need to be paid for. Please make payment. I am having trouble finding the time to chase down payments.

We are still a week away from being able to put tomatoes into shares. It will be a couple more weeks for heirloom types. Bushel orders will be available in about 3 weeks.
