We are walking and fixing fence. It is really a great experience to watch our world come alive. The trees are growing leaves, song birds are competing for attention, cowslips and flowers brighten the landscape. The pastures are about 2 weeks from needing some cows.

We went to an auction this past week to get fence posts, a wood chipper and a small excavator that will help us with landscaping and building projects.

Our barn roof and high tunnel took a beating during the wind storm a couple weeks ago. We lost one of the covers for the high tunnel and several pieces of roofing for the big barns.

One of the issues with buying back the farmstead are the overhead costs associated with it. They are aging facilities that need a lot of attention. We hope to have a successful season financially so we can do some roofing in the fall.
